## 2018 HIGHLIGHTS of Your Gifts in Action...

**Bike-Ped Trail Development** - Baldwin County Trailblazers (BCT) partnered with the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization to map all Baldwin County trails. The map will be available locally and online and will guide future trail development.



**Trail Maintenance** - BCT ensures the future viability of the Trail through ongoing oversight. Impediments and upgrades to the Trail were addressed through partnerships with Baldwin County and other local government agencies.

**Walking School Bus (WSB)** - If you see 100 joyful kids in a walking caravan to Fairhope Elementary School, you are witnessing the Trailblazers' commitment to making active citizens for life. Enrollment surged by 40 percent this year, supported by 31 business sponsors and your donations.



**Bike Valet** - To reduce parking demand and encourage active lifestyles, BCT operated supervised bike parking at four regional events. More than 100 cyclists used the service during the three-day Fairhope Arts & Crafts Festival.

**Public Safety** - BCT has led the effort to install outdoor signage and to distribute safety "rules for the road" for bicyclists and pedestrians.

**Advocacy** - BCT engages local officials, candidates for office and government agencies to promote the economic and social benefits of community trails.
